<p><b>Rose 'Hamilton Gardens'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Blend of Cream, Apricot, Peach and Salmon. Large, spiralled, perfectly formed flowers. Superb for picking. Sturdy growth. 1.1m.</p>	Pink
<p><b>Rose 'Hayley Westenra'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Frilly double blooms in shades of apricot cream and peach. Delightful perfume.</p>	Orange
<p><b>Rose 'Hayward College'</b>  Has deep red old-fashioned style blooms that have extremely weather resistant petals that last on the bush or in a vase for weeks. The bush is medium high with a compact habit. It has dark matte foliage and any new growth is a dark red-purple.</p>	Red
<p><b>Rose 'High Ho Silver'</b>  Beautifully formed flowers that have a hint of pink in the bud but open to reveal blooms of silvery lilac-grey. This rose has a delicious fragrance. It also repeats well throughout the season.</p>	Purple
<p><b>Rose 'Just Joey'</b>  Apricot blooms with a strong fragrance. Blooms mostly solitary, classic hybrid tea, ruffled bloom form. Blooms in flushes throughout the season.</p>	Orange
<p><b>Rose 'Ladies Night'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Flowers are red in the bud opening to reveal a pink centre. They tend to appear one to a stem making them great for picking. The plant is medium tall and upright and shows good disease resistance.</p>	Red
<p><b>Rose 'Land of the Long White Cloud'</b>  Lovely creamy white blooms with an overpowering fragrance, are carried on strong stems of a good healthy bush. Height 90cm - 1m.</p>	White
<p><b>Rose 'Love Heart'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Lovely shaped glowing red blooms that hold their colour well. Flowers usually appear singly on extremely long stems, they can get up to 600mm or more once well established. Few thorns and disease resistant.</p>	Red
<p><b>Rose 'Loving Memory'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Large perfect blooms of cherry red colour with strong stems. A tall upright bush with glossy green foliage, moderately scented with show potential.</p>	Red

<p><b>Rose 'Magnifi-Scent'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Strong damask fragrance, crimson red flowers that repeat well on a bushy plant.</p>	Red
<p><b>Rose 'My Girl'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Blooms of rose pink that keeps their colour in the sun. Bushy. Shorter height suitable for borders.</p>	Pink
<p><b>Rose 'Nelson Girls'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Well-formed blooms of creamy apricot tinged pink. Tall grower.</p>	Orange
<p><b>Rose 'Otago University'</b>  Shapely warm yellow blooms, mostly one to a stem. Lovely Picking variety. Medium Vigour. Named to commemorate the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the University of Otago.</p>	Yellow
<p><b>Rose 'Remember Me'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Coppery-orange irradiated with yellow. Well-formed medium blooms singly or clustered on strong upright bush.</p>	Orange
<p><b>Rose 'Tabasco'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Medium to large orange salmon blooms found both singularly and in substantial clusters. In full flower it is a magnificent sight. Nice upright bush.</p>	Orange
<p><b>Rose 'Tequila Sunrise'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Rich deep golden yellow blooms tipped orange-red. Freely produced. Brilliant garden display with an abundance for picking. Dense and bushy. Medium height.</p>	Yellow

## Old Fashioned Climber

<b>Rose 'Buff Beauty'</b> Double flowers of medium apricot-gold that repeat on a lusty and hardy bush. Very sweet scent.	
<b>Rose 'Paul Transon'</b> Attractive formal close petalled, salmon pink flowers of medium size. Flowers most of the season and again in autumn. Strong apple fragrance.	
<b>Rose 'Souvenir De La Malmaison'</b> Lovely blush white with face powder pink shadings. Each bloom is beautifully proportioned and opens out to a flat, quartered shape. Scented.	

## Rambler

<b>Rose 'Alberic Barbier'</b> Pretty yellow buds open into fully double, quartered, creamy white flowers, held in small clusters. The long, thin, flexible stems are easy to train. It is almost evergreen, with ample, glossy, dark green foliage.	
<b>Rose 'Tea Rambler'</b> Small, salmon-pink, double flowers in clusters. Fragrant and vigorous.	

## Rugosa

<b>Rose 'Roseaie de L'Hay'</b> <b>Award Winner.</b> One of the finest Rugosas, rich purple-crimson blooms produced repeatedly. Lovely fragrance. A strong growing shrub, sometimes bears hips.

<p><b>Rose 'Abraham Darby'</b> Large deep cupped flowers of soft peachy pink and pale-yellow reverse with a strong rich fragrance. Repeat flowering. Long arching growth with glossy disease resistant foliage. Height 1 - 1.5m.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Boscobel'</b> Perfect rosette blooms of rich salmon, with strong myrrh fragrance. Vigorous bushy growth, healthy.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Brother Cadfael'</b> Bears very large, globular, clear pink flowers, reminiscent of peonies. There is a particularly strong and rich Old Rose fragrance. It forms a bushy shrub.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Claire Austin'</b> A very large cupped bloom shaded apricot-yellow paling with age. Vigorous upright growth. For repeat flowering hard pruning is necessary. Fruity fragrance.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Charlotte'</b> Bears exquisite flowers of a soft yellow colour. Start off beautifully cupped, opening to form rosettes. There is a pleasant Tea fragrance.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Crown Princess Margareta'</b> Glorious, neatly formed rosettes of a lovely apricot-orange with a strong, fruity fragrance. A well-rounded, slightly arching growth. Repeat Flowering.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Everlyn'</b> A large flower in a mixture of apricot and yellow with a hint of pink, sometimes pink more dominant. Medium.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Gertrude Jekyll'</b> Large, rosette-shaped flowers of rich glowing pink. Upright, vigorous, medium sized shrub. Robust and free flowering. Delightful strong fragrance.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Golden Celebration'</b> <b>Award Winner.</b> A large deeply cupped rich golden yellow flower. Glossy dark green foliage, an ideal shrub rose. Very fragrant. Height medium.</p>	

<p><b>Rose 'Graham Thomas'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Fragrant deep yellow medium sized cupped blooms, tall bushy vigorous growth, perpetual blooms.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Heritage'</b>  Charming, soft clear pink, cup-shaped flowers. Beautiful fruit, honey and carnation fragrance on a myrrh background. Strong, bushy growth.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Lady of Shalott'</b>  Striking apricot-yellow, chalice-shaped blooms. Healthy with vigorous, bushy growth. A pleasant tea fragrance.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Mary Rose'</b>  Attractive, rose pink, loose-petalled blooms of medium size, which flower with unusual regularity throughout the summer. The delicious fragrance is of Old Rose character with a hint of honey and almond blossom. Vigorous twiggy growth.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Munstead Wood'</b>  <b>Award Winner.</b> Strong old rose fragrance. Buds are a light crimson becoming a very deep velvety crimson as the flower opens. A healthy bushy shrub. 1m.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Summer Song'</b>  Fully double, deeply cupped blooms of an unusual burnt orange colour that have a delicious fruity fragrance. Repeat is fast, and the upright bushy plant reaches approx. 1.2m.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'The Lady Gardener'</b>  Large, full petalled, rich apricot blooms. Strong and delicious tea fragrance. Repeat flowers quickly. Very healthy.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'The Poets Wife'</b>  Beautiful, cupped flowers with a rich, fruity fragrance. Bears rich yellow flowers, which pale over time. Their formation is most pleasing, having a neat outer ring of petals enclosing an informal group of petals within. It forms a bushy, nicely rounded shrub with arching branches and rather shiny foliage.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Thomas A Becket'</b>  Light red, informal rosettes. Old Rose fragrance. Natural, shrubby growth. Particularly reliable and healthy. Very quick repeating.</p>	

**Rose 'Tranquillity'**

Beautifully rounded flowers, with neatly placed petals making up perfect rosettes. The buds are lightly tinged with yellow but as the flowers open, they become pure white. A vigorous shrub; its growth is bushy and upright. With its pure white flowers, this rose lives up to its name.

**Rose 'William Shakespeare 2000'**

Stunning shallowly quartered flowers of the richest velvety crimson purple, and a fragrance to die for. Arching growth to about 1.5 m.

**Rose 'Wollerton Old Hall'**

One of the most fragrant of all English Roses. It has the distinctive myrrh scent which is rarely found in roses today. The plump buds have attractive flashes of red. These open to form round, rich buttery yellow coloured blooms which eventually pale to a softer creamy colour.

**Rose 'Yellow Charles Austin'**

A very strong growing rose with a powerful fragrance of bright yellow fading to buff. Flowers in great profusion throughout the season. Very healthy.

<p><b>Rose 'Blackberry Nip'</b> <b>Award Winner.</b> A vigorous climbing version, Deep unfading purple blooms of medium size on long stems, ideal for picking. Flowers early and repeats well, with dark silver-grey foliage. Medium height. Powerful old-fashioned fragrance.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Compassion'</b> <b>Award Winner.</b> Salmon pink shaded apricot orange, fragrant and very vigorous strong grower.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Double Fragrance'</b> <b>Award Winner.</b> Stunning dark red blooms, a delightfully powerful fragrance.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Dublin Bay'</b> <b>Award Winner.</b> Ever blooming clusters of bright red semi-double flowers. Healthy strong grower, quick covering.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Eye Spy'</b> It is a climbing Hulthemia hybrid peach blooms ageing to a honey colour with a dark red spot on the base of the petals. The foliage is large and glossy showing excellent health.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Golden Showers'</b> Loosely double, golden-yellow, paling with age. The blooms are large, open and semi-double and of a golden-yellow colour which fades to a light yellow. They have a sweet fragrance. Almost thornless.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Iceberg'</b> <b>Award Winner.</b> Clusters of pure white blooms which keep flowering. Strong tall grower, disease resistant.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Pierre De Ronsard'</b> The flowers are creamy white with over tones of lavender pink. Nice fragrance. Strong vigorous grower with bright green generous foliage.</p>	
<p><b>Rose 'Sally Holmes'</b> Clusters of large, single flowers literally cover the plant repeatedly. Creamy-Lemon, paling to white, fragrant blooms on a strong growing shrub.</p>	

<p><b>Rose 'Uetersen'</b> Large clusters of bright pink frilly blooms with fragrance. Very free flowering, with glossy light green foliage. Moderate spreading habit ideal for a small area or pillar.</p>
